### This Term ...

Welcome back, we hope you enjoyed your Summer! We have already made a fantastic start to our year, and we look forward to continuing this.

We are focusing on the topics: Significant People and Let's Explore the World. These are our driver History and Geography projects where we will be studying important historical figures who shaped their fields and we will be looking at map, atlases and compass directions.

In English, we will be reading Goldilocks by Lauren Child and by the end of the half term we will have written our own sequel to the original story! The children will be building on their knowledge from Year 1 and will start to explore writing for different audiences.

Our Maths learning begins with place value, where we are building upon knowledge learnt in Year 1, to progress onto recognising and using numbers up to 100 in addition and subtraction later in the year. We will also continue our work on counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
