Formalise knowledge of days of the week and learn time in digital form to discuss when you do subjects. Recap ordinal numbers to say what you have in first lesson etc. Revise and extend use of adjectives to describe teachers. Talk about their possessions and hobbies. Learn key phrases to describe a classroom. Work out the meaning of school rules.

Learn more about activism in German-speaking countries.
Discuss issues facing young people today. Discuss how environmental issues are being addressed. Discuss personal and international responsibilities and actions.

Knowledge (Grammar)

Meine Welt und ich:

Understand concept of gender in German – masculine, feminine and neuter. Use definite and indefinite articles. Use the verbs *haben*, *sein* and *wohnen* (simple present, first person). Be able to ask basic questions. Use basic connectives and qualifiers. Introduction to the accusative.

Bleib gesund:

Recap and extend formation of irregular verbs (essen and trinken) in all three time frames. Revise use of 'kein'. Revise word order rules with time phrases. Gentle introduction to perfect tense to describe a past visit to a restaurant. Understand the 'du' form of the imperative.

Zurück zur Schule! (Kapitel 1):

Use articles and plural nouns. Recap present tense verbs (regular and irregular). Give reasons using denn or weil and necessary word order. Revise and extend use of accusative adjective endings (after the indefinite article). Expand use of modal verbs: müssen, sollen, dürfen. Use opinions phrases with

Meine Ecke (Kapitel 5):

Revise the comparative and the superlative. Use prepositions until the accusative and the dative. Use a variety of adjectives with intensifiers and qualifiers. Understand register. Revise forming plurals of nouns. Use a range of tenses. Revise the conditional tense.

Familie und Tiere:

Use 'kein' to say what you don't have. Use pronouns. Add 'super' to adjectives. Look at how to make nouns plural in German. Use 'können + infinitive at the end of the clause. More practice of present tense verbs. Look at the plural form of nouns. Recognise adjectival agreement (for plural nouns) Use hell- and dunkel to qualify colours. Begin to use 'Es gibt + accusative'. Use haben and sein in all singular forms.

Freizeit:

Learn the verb endings for a full paradigm of a regular verb. Use *gern* and *nicht gern* to express opinions. Recognise some key irregular verbs. Introduce word order after time expressions. Talk about the future using the present tense with a future time phrase.

Meine Schule:

Understand word order with connective 'weil' (verb to the end of the clause). Practise the verb as second idea rule. Learn to say 'his' and 'her'. Learn some key prepositions and recognise their effect in a sentence. Look at the plural form of nouns. Introduce the irregular modal verb 'dürfen' for comprehension.

In den Sommerferien:

Understand and begin to use the comparative form of adjectives. Use modal verbs to give advice on living a healthier lifestyle and recap future tense to say what you will do.

Ich liebe Ferien:

Use some key expressions in the imperfect tense (es war / es gab / es hatte). Understand expressions in the perfect tense using 'haben' and 'sein' and use them in the 'ich' and 'wir' forms. Combine the present and perfect tense.

Bist du ein Medienfan?:

Revise and extend giving opinions using adverbs. Recap plural forms of nouns. Review perfect tense. Use prepositions with the dative case. Use the modal verbs *sollen*, *dürfen* and *können*.

Wir gehen aus:

Form adjectives correctly in accusative case. Understand and adapt 'wenn' clauses. Understand and apply 'Time, Manner, Place' word order rule. Be able to form questions (swapping verb and subject). Recap all three tenses.
